## Six River Marine Launches Custom West Pointer '19'

**North Yarmouth, Maine (September, 2008)** – Six River Marine is pleased to announce the launch of yet another boat from its West Pointer series. With sea trials complete and having recently been on public display at the Maine Boats Homes & Harbors show in Rockland, Maine, she's now been delivered to her new owner in Wisconsin.

Six River Marine has been building West Pointer's for a number of years now, but this one was quite different as the owner had a number of specific requirements that were not standard features of the boat.

First and foremost, the owner wanted seating forward and aft that would comfortably accommodate seven adults. This also meant a slight increase in LOA to 19' from the standard 18', 6". A new cockpit configuration had to be designed and the result was an elliptical layout that allowed curved seating areas forward and aft of the helm position. The entire cockpit then received a varnished mahogany coaming. A well for the 50hp Yamaha outboard was also desired and needed to mirror image the elegant curvature of the cockpit's coaming. At the helm, the owner wanted a custom Captain's seat that would tie in with the aesthetics of the new boat. Six River Marine's co-owner, Scott Conrad, hand-crafted a mahogany seat complete with dovetails, which provided an elegant solution. The boat also includes an oiled teak cockpit floor, and bronze running lights, cleats, chafe strips, chocks etc. The cold-molded hull, as well as the weather decks and interior ceiling, has been painted with Awlgrip. The new boat, named '*Chrissy's Craft*', will ply the waters of Lake Oconomowoc in Wisconsin where she'll serve as the family's recreational launch.

"Every West Pointer we build is an enjoyable process but this boat was especially gratifying", noted Six River Marine co-owner, Chip Miller. "The boat's owner had very definite ideas on what he wanted, and it was a challenge to successfully incorporate all of his feature requests. In the end, this collaborative process turned out to be a resounding success. The owner is excited about the boat and all of us are quite proud of her as well."
