

On Auaust 24. MARINERS 2017. Maine Maritime AWARD Museum honored Maine boatbuilders with the 12th annual Mariners Award, given to an individual or organization has made extraordinarv that contributions to Maine's maritime heritage and significantly impacted the state's culture and economy. The award was presented to Maine Built Boats on behalf of all of the state's boatbuilders. Jon Johansen, president of Maine Built Boats, accepted the award.

Around 150 guests, including community members, museum supporters, and boatbuilders, attended the celebration. Proceeds from ticket sales and live and silent auctions will support the museum's traditional skills programs.
